## How to engage with the blind or visually impaired person

- Speak directly to the person not through others
  Do not shout
  - 3. Always introduce yourself
- 4. Announce yourself when you're entering or leaving a room
  - 5. Using words like see or look are not offensive
  - 6. Be specific when providing directions in relations to the person; state left/right, up/down or the hour on a clock (I.e. it is at your "2 o'clock")
- 7. Pointing, using gestures or saying over there do not provide a reference
  - 8. Always ask before providing assistance, it may not be needed
- 9. Never push, pull, or grab a blind person, instead, ask to use sighted guide technique
  - 10. Never pet or speak to guide dogs; communicate with the owner.

Most importantly, don't be afraid to make mistakes, just be willing to apologize when they do occur, a friend is only a conversation away.
